Furniture Collection

We collect worn and damaged furniture from public and partners like junk haulers.

We focus on basic items that cannot be donated to other organizations and are generally suitable for smaller spaces.

Repair & Redesign

We are building a community of mighty, courageous, and empathic individuals:

- We revive discarded items by repairing, refurbishing, and redesigning to like-new condition.
- No skills required to join us! We help build restoration skills.
- We specialize in one-off events and help companies and groups meet their volunteer goals.





Equitable access






